



# UNIFORM POLICY

## St Patrick's School Lithgow

Students of St Patrick's are expected to wear full school uniforms. We encourage students to take pride in their appearance by wearing the correct school uniform as it demonstrates unity and school spirit. If at any time the correct uniform cannot be worn, a note explaining the reason should be given to the class teacher. Any adjustments to the school uniform must be approved by the Principal.

If students present at school wearing the incorrect school uniform, a note will be sent home to parents (see Appendix A).

School uniforms are available to purchase from Lithgow Kidswear and Embroidery, 167 Main Street Lithgow and will be open for families to visit on Monday to Friday from 9:00am to 4:45pm.

### Girls

**Summer** - Pink checked uniform, fawn socks, black leather school shoes, pink or maroon hair ribbons, maroon school hat, maroon sloppy joe with school emblem or maroon wool blend jumper with school emblem.

**Sport** - White polo shirt with school emblem, shorts or skort, white socks, white joggers, maroon school tracksuit, maroon school hat - wide brim or maroon beanie.

**Winter** - Maroon A line pinafore or maroon slacks, fawn shirt, school tie, maroon wool blend jumper/sloppy joe with school emblem, fawn socks or tights, black shoes, maroon parka, maroon scarf, maroon school hat or maroon beanie.

### Boys

**Summer** - Grey shorts, green shirt, grey socks, black school shoes, maroon school hat, maroon sloppy joe with school emblem or maroon wool blend jumper with school emblem.

**Sport** - Gold polo shirt with school emblem, maroon shorts, maroon school tracksuit, white socks, white joggers, maroon school hat – wide brim or maroon beanie.

**Winter** - Long grey serge trousers, green shirt, grey socks, black school shoes, maroon sloppy joe with school emblem or maroon wool blend jumper with school emblem, maroon parka, maroon school hat or beanie.

### Sun Safe Policy:

**NO SCHOOL HAT NO PLAY** St Patrick's adopted this policy in keeping with the 'Sunsmart' Skin Cancer Policy.

### Miscellaneous:

#### ***Hats, Beanies and Jackets***

- Hats, beanies and jackets are to be maroon and the approved school style only.

#### ***Socks***

- Socks are to be the appropriate school colours and are not to have writing or brand names on them.

#### ***Pants***

- Jeans, cargo pants or cargo shorts are not permitted.

#### ***Shoes***

- School shoes must be appropriate black school shoes. Skater shoes, canvas shoes and black joggers are not acceptable forms of school shoes.
- Joggers are only to be worn on sports days.
- "Light up" joggers are not permitted.

#### ***Nails***

- Nail polish is not permitted.
- Acrylic nails are not permitted.

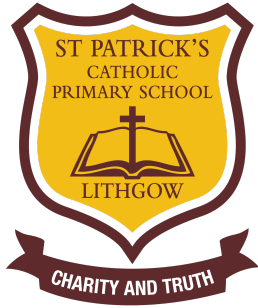
#### ***Hair***

- Hair longer than the shirt collar must be tied back neatly.
- Haircuts are to be neat and tidy without "cut in" patterns.
- Dyed, streaked or tinted hair is not permitted.
- Hair accessories are to be simple and maroon (and/or pink in summer).

#### ***Jewellery***

- Jewellery, other than a wrist watch, signet ring, studs or sleepers (one in each ear for girls only), is not permitted.
